

California Online Privacy Protection Act California Website Privacy Policy

Effective January 1, 2014

This California Website Privacy Policy describes our practices in connection with information that we collect through websites that link to this Privacy Policy.

Financial Center Credit Union respects your privacy and wants you to be familiar with how we collect, use and disclose information as it relates to our websites.

Collection of Data

Financial Center Credit Union may collect the following types of information when you use any Financial Center Credit Union website:

- Personal information you provide directly (including your name, address, telephone number, and email address) when you complete an online registration form, online loan request or fill out an online form. Providing this information or completing these types of forms is completely voluntary. You may visit a Financial Center Credit Union website without identifying yourself or sharing any personal information.
- Non-personally identifiable usage data, such as IP address, web browser type/version operating system, and website visit information such as date, time, pages viewed, and amount of time spent on pages.
- Aggregate, non-personally identifiable information, such as the number of weekly visits or page views to the Financial Center Credit Union websites.
- Financial Center Credit Union does not collect personally identifiable information about your online activities over time and across different Web sites when you use our web site or service.

Changes to personally identifiable information

The only information that Financial Center Credit Union collects is strictly on a voluntary basis. If you would like to request a change to any of your personally identifiable information that you have previously provided you must contact our call center at 209-948-6024 and present your request to them.

We do not respond to Web browser “do not track” signals. Additionally, third parties do not collect personally identifiable information about your online activities through our website.
